

- I. **Kindergarten, Pre-Kindergarten, and Early Childhood Students** -All students entering the above mentioned grades for the first time must present proof of a current physical examination and immunization record by **October 15**. Pre-K, ECE and K must provide proof of one dose of pneumococcal conjugate vaccine if student is under five years old. Kindergarten students shall show proof of 2 doses of varicella vaccine, the first dose on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than 28 days after the first dose, or proof of prior varicella disease documented by a physician. In addition to these requirements, Kindergarten students are required to have a current dental examination on file in the school office by **May 15**. A new law as of January 1, 2008 also requires a Kindergarten student or a student new to an Illinois school to have an eye examination. This is due by **October 15**. Records presented to the school must be current and within one calendar year of the registration date. PLEASE NOTE: All students are required to present a county issued Certificate of Live Birth prior to entering school. Hospital issued certificates cannot be accepted. Physical and up to date vaccination form must be turned in by **October 15** or your student will be excluded.
- II. **Second Grade Students**- Current dental exam on file by **May 15**.
- III. **Sixth Grade Students**- Hepatitis B and meningococcal are mandated vaccinations for sixth grade. Most children are given the Hepatitis B immunizations as infants. Please verify with healthcare provider before restarting the series. Sixth graders shall show proof of 2 doses of varicella vaccine, the first dose on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than 28 days after the first dose, or proof of prior varicella disease documented by a physician. Sixth Grade students are also required to present a school physical before **October 15**. A sports physical will not be accepted. 6<sup>th</sup> graders must turn in state dental exam form by **May 15**. Physical and up to date vaccination form must be turned in by October 15 or your student will be excluded.
- IV. **Sixth Through Twelfth Grade Students** -All students in sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth, eleventh and twelfth grade must provide proof of Tdap immunization. If these records are not presented by **October 15**, your child will be excluded from school.
- V. **Ninth Grade Students**-All students in ninth grade must provide proof of a school physical and an up to date immunization record by **October 15**. 9<sup>th</sup> graders shall show proof of 2 doses of varicella vaccine, the first dose on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than 28 days after the first dose, or proof of prior varicella disease documented by a physician. A sports physical will not be accepted. Physical and up to date vaccination form must be turned in by **October 15** or your student will be excluded from school.
- VI. **Twelfth Grade Students**-Meningococcal vaccine required to be given after reaching the age of sixteen for seniors. Vaccination form must be turned in by **October 15** or your student will be excluded from school.
- VII. **All students entering Olympia Schools from out of state or country**- will be required to present a current physical and eye examination obtained in the state of Illinois and immunization record within thirty days of entering school. In addition, students entering

Kindergarten and Second Grade will be required to present a current dental examination. Physical examinations, immunization records, dental and eye examinations presented to the school must be current, within one calendar year of the registration date. If these records have not been presented by **October 15**, your child will be excluded from school. (Or thirty days from the registration date, if the student enters school after the first day of school).
